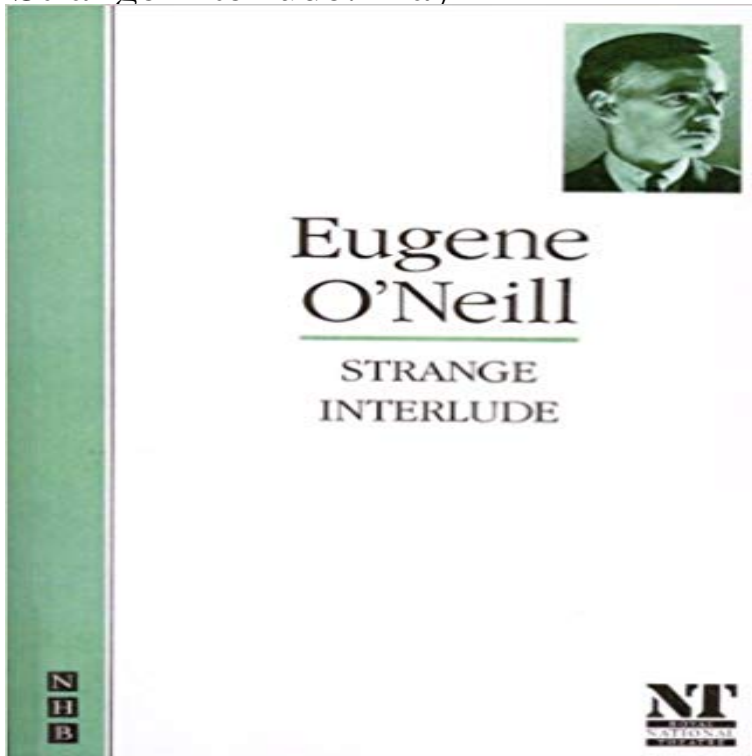


Strange Interlude: Play
