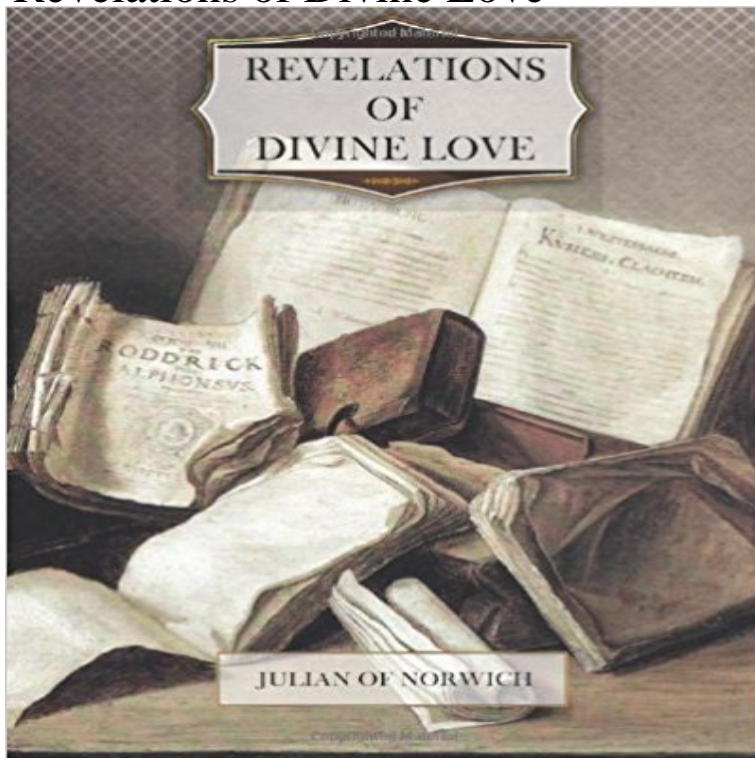


Revelations of Divine Love
